Monitoring registers with DPMAkurier

DPMAkurier allows automated monitoring of IP rights in **DPMAregister**. Upon a first-time registration, you will receive information on new publications and register updates on a regular basis. The e-mails are sent on a daily, weekly or monthly basis – depending on the selected delivery frequency.

The e-mail will contain information on the results or register updates and a link to the respective data record in DPMAregister.

You have the following options for monitoring:

- Monitoring legal and procedural status data by file numbers/publication numbers You can enter up to 500 file numbers or publication numbers for each type of IP right.
- Monitoring IP rights by names You can enter up to 50 different names of applicants, inventors or owners for each type of IP right.
- Monitoring IP rights by classes
 - For patents/utility models, you can enter up to 100 IPC symbols,
 - for trade marks, up to 45 classes of the Nice Classification,
 - for registered designs, up to 100 classes of the classification for designs.
- Subscription to the Patent Gazette, Trade Mark Journal or Designs Gazette You will receive the link to the PDF version of the complete publications or parts thereof on a regular basis.

Official Publication and Register Database

What is **DPMA**register?

Via **DPMAregister**, the German Patent and Trade Mark Office (DPMA) makes available the statutory publications as well as information on current legal and procedural status data on patents, utility models, trade marks, indications of geographical origin and registered designs.

You have various options to conduct a search, from the Beginner's search mode to the Expert search mode. You will get configurable, sortable and downloadable result lists for your search. For the individual results, the current register information pages containing the respective legal and procedural status data will be displayed. The register entry can be printed out or downloaded. You will thereby receive the complete register extract.

Update frequency

We update the register and procedural status data on a daily basis, the publication data on a weekly basis in parallel with the Patent Gazette (Patentblatt), Trade Mark Journal (Markenblatt) and Designs Gazette (Designblatt).

Costs

The use of **DPMAregister** is free of charge.

File inspection

As from 7 January 2014, you have the option of online file inspection of patent and utility model files.

Information regarding the supply of large amounts of data:

With DPMAconnectPlus, the DPMA offers a web-based user interface with DPMAregister and DEPATISnet. What kind of data is available?

Patents und utility models

- published patent applications and granted patents (since 1 January 1981), registered utility models (since 1 January 1981)
- published and granted patents of the former GDR (1951–1990)
- first published and granted European patents
- international publications (WO) with a German designation
- data on supplementary protection certificates for medicinal and plant protection products
- topographies

Trade marks

- all register data on all currently registered
 German trade marks (since October 1894)
- all data since 1 January 1998 on
 - German trade mark applications
 - refused or withdrawn German trade mark applications
 - cancelled German trade marks
- indications of geographical origin (only applications)
- European Union trade marks of the European Union Intellectual Property Office (EUIPO)
- international registrations at the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) with DE or EU (EM) designation

Registered designs

- all register data on all design applications and all registered and cancelled designs since 1 July 1988
- all procedural data on all registered and cancelled designs since 1 January 1998 (prior to that date: incomplete file history)
- all illustrations of designs registered since 1 June 2004 (prior to that date: usually, publication of only one black-and-white illustration per design)
- Community designs which were registered by the European Union Intellectual Property Office (EUIPO)

Which search modes are available?

Beginner's search

Select the Beginner's mode if you are a newcomer or have little IP searching experience.

Expert search

Select the Expert mode if you are experienced in searches. This search mode allows you to create more complex search queries.

Monitoring

This mode is suitable for searches for first publications of IP rights in a monitoring period in the past. You can automate monitoring tasks using the **DPMAkurier** service.

PIZ support

Are you unsure how to formulate a search query in the search form or how to design a search strategy? In this mode, you can send an informal question to the experts of the German patent information centres (PIZ). You will receive a fast and informed answer by e-mail, post or fax. Initial support is free of charge. You may also receive payable additional support.

You can also download issues of the Patent Gazette since 1878, of the Trade Mark Journal since 1950 and of the Designs Gazette since 1988 in a separate menu item.
